What a crazy year 2020 has turned out to be. After coming home from Delaware in March I did not go back out on the road again until August. That's 145 days between projects, which is twice as long as we were sidelined by Hurricane Irene in 2011! Nevertheless, we were able to get some things accomplished in that time. We turned a room in our church basement into a full-time Seedline room, and we are finally back to working on Scriptures on a weekly basis. In June we also did a weekend project here at our home church, assembling 10,000 English John and Romans for a church plant in Wilmington, Delaware. Finally, in August, we were able to go back out and do two projects in Connecticut: 9,000 English and Spanish at Long Hill Baptist Church (Trumbull) and 7,000 English and Spanish at Galilean Baptist Church (Stafford Springs). Both of those projects were originally scheduled for the spring, and I'm thankful we were able to get them rescheduled. I have a total of eight more projects scheduled for the rest of the year in New York, New Jersey, and Pennsylvania. Barring unforeseen circumstances, I shouldn't have any trouble with travel restrictions in those states. Thank you for your prayers for and support of our ministry. We consider it a privilege to labor alongside so many wonderful churches who have a heart and desire to get the Word of God to a lost and dying world.
